

## Awareness Program on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR):: Report – 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> June 2022

Intellectual Property Rights are a common type of legal IP protection for those who invent. Intellectual Property (IP) refers to creations of mind, such as inventions; literary and artistic works; designs; and symbols, names and images etc. To protect, provide security and enhance the intrinsic value of such intangible properties, intellectual property rights (IPR) laws were enacted.

To create more awareness on IPR and to make their hard earned innovative work secured a workshop was conducted by IQAC of AITS, Tirupati in association with the student chapters of ISTE, IEEE and CSI.

The awareness workshop has been planned for two days:  $27^{th}$  and  $28^{th}$  June 2022 in three sessions: Two sessions for the students ( $27^{th}$  June 2022) and one session for the faculty ( $28^{th}$  June 2022).
