BOYS

Cricket

Cricket was a popular sport among the boys. There were a total of 9 teams participating in the event, with each team playing a total of 8 matches. An impressive 135 boys took part in the cricket tournament.

Volleyball

Volleyball was another favored sport among the boys. The tournament consisted of 8 teams, each playing 7 matches. A total of 80 boys participated in the volleyball competition.

Shuttle (Badminton)

Badminton, or shuttle as it's commonly referred to, was played by both boys and girls. Among the boys, there were 9 teams engaging in 8 matches. The total number of boy participants for badminton was 18.

Kabaddi

Kabaddi was a popular choice for both genders. For the boys, there were 8 teams competing in 7 matches, with a total of 80 participants.

Carroms

Carroms was yet another game enjoyed by both boys and girls. Among the boys, 8 teams participated in 7 matches. The total number of boy participants for carroms was 16.

Chess

Chess, a game of intellect, was also organized for the boys. There were 8 teams competing in 7 matches. A total of 8 boys participated in the chess tournament.

GIRLS

Throwball

Throwball was exclusively played by the girls. There were 7 teams participating in 6 matches. A total of 70 girls took part in the throwball competition.

Tennikoit

Tennikoit was another sport enjoyed by the girls. There were 7 teams competing in 6 matches. The total number of girl participants for tennikoit was 14.

Shuttle (Badminton)

As mentioned earlier, badminton was a mixed-gender sport. Among the girls, there were 7 teams participating in 6 matches. The total number of girl participants for badminton was 14.

Kabaddi

Kabaddi was popular among the girls as well. There were 8 teams competing in 7 matches. A total of 80 girls participated in the kabaddi tournament.

Carroms

Carroms was also played by the girls. There were 6 teams competing in 5 matches. The total number of girl participants for carroms was 12.

Chess

Chess was also organized for the girls. There were 5 teams competing in 4 matches. A total of 5 girls participated in the chess tournament.
